

Snake-Roll-Spey cast with a two-handed rod

Water flow

Start with the fly-line fully extended, downstream and the rod-tip close to the water.

Raise the rod-tip towards the river-bank and begin to trace an elliptical path, rotating over and away from the river bank.

Increase rod-tip speed, following the elliptical path, and tuck the fly-line under itself.

Sweep the rod-tip back on an inclined path, causing the fly-line to turn over, lined up in the direction of the final cast.

Use the bottom-hand to rapidly accelerate the rod-tip back and circle up with the top-hand, as the line-tip passes over the anchor point, to the key position for the forward-cast.

Make the forward cast in the normal manner, leading and then rotating using the bottom hand.
